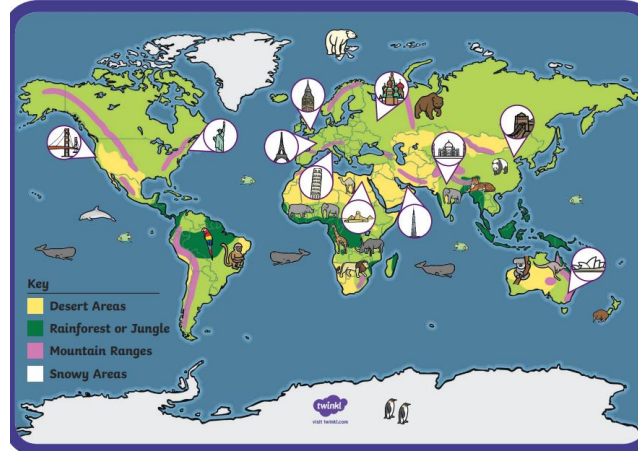


Knowledge Organiser: Megastructures

Subject Specific Vocabulary	
buildings	A building is a structure that has a roof and walls
architecture	The way buildings are designed
construct	To make something by arranging the parts
houses	A building or shelter made by humans to live in
bridge	A structure built over something so people can cross
structure	Anything made up of parts
walls	Something used to divide or enclose an area
tools	Items used to make things
height and depth	Height is measured bottom to top Depth is measured back to front
