We will be working on the following spellings during this half term. We have split the spellings as we will be working on them in class over the next few weeks.

On Fridays, the children will be given a short spelling test covering the spellings we have been practising in class throughout the week. Please support your child to learn the spellings at home. We encourage the children to learn the spellings by using the Look, Say, Cover, Write, Check method. Where appropriate, please encourage your child to think of additional spellings that fit the spelling pattern/rule.

Week Beginning	Spellings
Monday 31st Oct.	busy, people, water, again, half, money, Mr, Mrs, Christmas, parents, everybody, even (Y2 CEW).
Monday 7 <sup>th</sup> Nov.	badge, fudge, edge, bridge, dodge, fridge, smudge, sledge, grudge, nudge (dge for 'j' sound following a short vowel).
Monday 14 <sup>th</sup> Nov.	age, huge, village, charge, change, bulge, plunge, strange, verge, wage ('j' sound made with ge at the end of words).
Monday 21st Nov.	gem, giant, giraffe, magic, energy, jacket, jar, jog, adjust, join ('j' sound is always spelt with j before a, o, u. 'j' sound usually-but not always- spelt with g before e, i, y).
Monday 28 <sup>th</sup> Nov.	race, ice, city, cell, fancy, face, place, mice, pencil, circus ('s' sound spelt with soft c before e, i, y).
Monday 5 <sup>th</sup> Dec.	knock, know, knew, knee, knot, gnat, gnaw, gnome, gnash ('n' sound spelt kn or gn at the beginning of words).
Monday 12th Dec & Monday 19 <sup>th</sup> Dec	Revision weeks – we will recap the 20 most common errors from this half term's spellings.
