Year 1 Visit to Old Kay's Park - 1st July 2026

Dear Parents and Carers,

We are delighted to inform you that we have rearranged our educational visit for Year 1 to Old Kay's park on the **1st July 2026**. This visit will enhance the children's current Geography learning about 'Our Local Area' whilst also making a link to our science topic of 'Plants'.

During our visit, we will walk down Tottington Lines and try to spot different sights relevant to our school - Peel Tower, Henry Wood's house and of course John Kay's park. When we arrive at Old Kay's, we plan to let the children enjoy the newly renovated park area as well as having a lovely picnic outdoors. This will be a fantastic opportunity for the children to really understand our school's history and bring some of the buildings to life.

We will be leaving school at 10:30am to walk to the park.

Return to school for 2:30.

As we are walking to the park, there will be no voluntary contribution necessary for this trip.

Clothing: School uniform must be worn along with comfortable shoes. Children will need a light waterproof jacket and may need a sun hat/glasses depending on the weather. Sun cream must be applied before arriving at school.

Children can pre order a packed lunch provided by school on School Grid, or they can bring a packed lunch from home. Please note: Children must bring packed lunches in a disposable bag, labelled clearly with their name. No lunch boxes or flasks can be carried on the trip. We can then dispose of all rubbish in the bins at the park and

children do not need to carry it all back. **If possible, children should bring a backpack/rucksack to put their lunch in that they are comfortable carrying. As we are walking, children will need to carry their own lunch to the park.**

*As you have already signed and consented for this trip, **no consent slip is necessary this time.***
