Dear Parents and Carers,

We are pleased to inform you that we have organised a trip for all the children in Key Stage 1 to visit Blackpool as part of our topic 'Oh I Do Like to Be Beside The Seaside'.

We will be taking the children in their year groups on two separate days: **Year 2** will go on **Wednesday 21st June** and **Year 1** will go on **Thursday 29<sup>th</sup> June**. The cost of the trip will be **£26.00** per child, which is a voluntary contribution.

Please contribute for the visit and consent on School Money by **Monday 19<sup>th</sup> June** at the latest. Please note although this is a voluntary contribution, the visit will not go ahead if we do not receive sufficient funds.

During the trip, children will be taken on a Heritage Tram Tour where they will get a 1 hour guided tour of Blackpool's promenades and piers learning all about the changes which have taken place in Blackpool in recent years. Children will also be taught about the geographical features found in the coastal region of Blackpool, which we will compare with where we live after the trip.

As soon as we arrive, we will be dropped off at North Pier where there are toilets and this is where we will position ourselves for our time on the beach. We will spend time enjoying building sandcastles and having fun together. After that, we will eat lunch before being collected by the tram company at North Pier and setting off on our tour. Built into the cost is also the price of an ice cream (£2)- you can't go to the seaside and not have an ice-cream, can you?

As we will be out for the whole day we could like children you bring with them:

- a small rucksack, which they can carry on their back
- their packed lunch
- drinks
- extra sun cream if needed- **please let your child's class teacher know if you do not give consent for sun cream to applied to your child whilst on the trip**
- a hat
- a small bucket and spade if it fits 😊

If your child has school dinners and you would like to order a school packed lunch for the visit, please order this with the school office (the choice of sandwich filling will be cheese, tuna mayo, egg mayo or ham). Otherwise your child can bring their own packed lunch and drink.

We will be leaving school at 9:15am and return at 4:30pm. We would like children to come to school in appropriate summer wear and dress for the weather that day. A light coat would be advisable. Children will be wearing hi-visibility jackets throughout for safety.
