to wear comfy shoes, depending on the weather, we might get the chance to explore the Castle woodland area. No spending money is required for this visit.

If you want your child to have a school packed lunch, it needs to be ordered on School Grid by Monday 4th March. Please ensure you select the sandwich option only. The choices on School Grid are ham, cheese, tuna mayonnaise or egg mayonnaise.

If you do not order by the 4th March your child needs to bring a packed lunch from home, this needs to be in a disposable carrier bag, with their name clearly written on it. No lunch boxes or flasks will be allowed on the trip. (We don't want to carry anything back!)

If you would like your child to visit Skipton Castle, please log into school money to give consent and make contribution by Friday 1st of March. Contributions are voluntary but if there are insufficient funds available then the visit may not go ahead.
