Subject Specific Vocabulary	
Polar regions	Places near the North and South pole.
Earth	The planet we live on.
Inuit	A member of the indigenous people from parts of Canada, Greenland and Alaska.
ice / iceberg	Frozen water. A floating mass of ice.
weather	The state of the air and atmosphere at a particular time and place.
glacier	A slow-moving mass of ice.
Antarctica	The continent covering the South pole.
The Arctic	The area of land surrounding the North Pole.
The equator	It is an imaginary line around the Earth that goes exactly midway between the North Pole and the South Pole
