**Key Stage 1 Visit to Towneley Hall - June 2024**

Dear Parents and Carers,

We are delighted to inform you that we have now been able to confirm the booking for Key Stage One to visit Towneley Hall. Hazel Class will be going on **Wednesday 19<sup>th</sup> June** and Holly Class will be visiting on **Wednesday 26<sup>th</sup> June**.

As mentioned in our previous letter, this visit will enhance our History topic about 'Toys from the Past' whilst also making a link between our Science learning on habitats.

During our visit, the children will be led by a guide inside the Hall to play with old toys and games from the past. They will also have the opportunity to dress up in traditional Victorian clothes and look at old, wooden objects such as dolly tubs and clogs. The children then be taken to explore more of the parkland and view Burnley's oldest oak tree! The second half of our visit includes a workshop where children will be hunting for minibeasts, pond dipping and observing flying insects. This will be a fantastic opportunity to bring the children's learning to life and will be a wonderful experience!
