- Wednesday 17th June – Towneley Hall trip


Summer 2 - Curriculum Information

English

The children will be exploring two texts this half term, the first of which is '10 Things I Can Do To Change My World'. This thought provoking book encourages the children to think about caring for our planet and that if we all work together we can make a difference. The second text is 'The Secret of Black Rock' and is an exciting adventure story. The children will be enhancing their vocabulary and writing a variety of poems in different styles.

Maths We are focussing on volume, word problems and revising key concepts. The children will still have access to their Numbots and TTRockstars accounts so any additional practise at home would be greatly appreciated!
