On Fridays, the children will be given a short spelling test covering the spellings we have been practising in class throughout the week. Please support your child to learn the spellings at home. We encourage the children to learn the spellings by using the Look, Say, Cover, Write, Check method. Where appropriate, please encourage your child to think of additional spellings that fit the spelling pattern/rule.

Monday 23 <sup>rd</sup> Sept	gym, mystery, physical, myth, system, pyramid, Egypt, hymn, symbol, gymnastics (y for short i sound)
Monday 30 <sup>th</sup> Sept	school, Christmas, chemist, scheme, chorus, echo, stomach, character, ache, anchor (/k/ sound spelt 'ch')
Monday 7 <sup>th</sup> Oct	tongue, league, fatigue, plague, vague, mosque, unique, antique, cheque, technique (gue and que word endings)
Monday 14 <sup>th</sup> Oct	chalet, chef, machine, brochure, parachute, chute, crochet, quiche, brioche, chiffon (/sh/ as 'ch')
