On Fridays, the children will be given a short spelling test covering the spellings we have been practising in class throughout the week. Please support your child to learn the spellings at home. We encourage the children to learn the spellings by using the Look, Say, Cover, Write, Check method. Where appropriate, please encourage your child to think of additional spellings that fit the spelling pattern/rule.

Week Beginning	Spellings
Monday 28 th Oct	double, trouble, young, touch, couple, country, cousin, enough, rough, tough (short u sound spelt ou)
Monday 4 th Nov	measure, treasure, pleasure, usual, casual, usually, enclosure, closure, leisure, composure (zh sound)
Monday 11 th Nov	picture, nature, creature, capture, future, adventure, furniture, fracture, mixture, structure (ture)
Monday 18 th Nov	special, actual, hospital, candle, handle, bottle, camel, novel, fossil, tonsil (different l endings)
Monday 25 th Nov	wait, weight, reign, rain, knight, night, deer, dear, berry, bury (homophones/near homophones)
Monday 2 nd Dec	lamb, comb, climb, crumb, thumb, knee, kneel, knew, knock, knot (silent letters)
Monday 9 th Dec	Foxes, boxes, buses, brushes, berries, ponies, flies, wolves, calves, hooves (plurals)
