Where appropriate, please encourage your child to think of additional spellings that fit the spelling pattern/rule.

Monday 1st Dec	lamb, comb, climb, crumb, thumb, knee, kneel, knew, knock, knot (silent letters)
Monday 8th Dec	Foxes, boxes, buses, brushes, berries, ponies, flies, wolves, calves, hooves (plurals)
