

# Home Learning Challenges

### The Stone Age to the Iron Age

Create a fact file about Stonehenge with illustrations. Tell me why you think it was built. (up to 5 merits)

The wheel was invented in the stone age. Build something that requires a wheel/wheels. (up to 5 merits)

Research the different houses during the stone age, bronze age and iron age. Draw a picture comparing them and label them with their features. (3 merits)

Write a non-chronological report with illustrations about an animal that early humans hunted. (up to 6 merits)

Up until Christmas, we will be learning about The Stone Age to the Iron Age. Please complete a minimum of 3 and a maximum of 5 challenges. Complete your work in your Home Learning Challenge (HLC) book. Work can also be submitted on Seesaw but please make a note of this in your HLC book if so. You should aim to spend about half an hour each week on your challenges. Any writing should be in your own words, please do not simply copy and paste from the internet. Take pride in each piece of work and have fun!!

Write an acrostic poem about the stone age, bronze age or iron age. (up to 3 merits)

Make up your own story and tell it through cave paintings. (up to 3 merits)

Build a model of Stonehenge. Be as creative as you want! (up to 5 merits)

Stone age people could not pop to the shops for food. Everything they ate had to be caught or collected. Write your own recipe and instructions for a stone age dinner using the sort of ingredients that would be available to them. Bonus merits if you make it too! (up to 6 merits)
