Dear Parents and Carers,

We will be working on the following spellings during this half term. We have split the spellings as we will be working on them in class over the next few weeks.

On Fridays, the children will be given a short spelling test covering the spellings we have been practising in class throughout the week. Please support your child to learn the spellings at home. We encourage the children to learn the spellings by using the Look, Say, Cover, Write, Check method. Where appropriate, please encourage your child to think of additional spellings that fit the spelling pattern/rule.

Week Beginning	Spellings
8 th September	grey, place, away, table, prey beige, veil, vein, reign, reindeer (revision of ai sounds from KS1 and new 'ei' sound)
15 th September	weight, sleigh, weigh, eight, neighbour, neigh, eighteen, weightless, eighty, freight (eigh for ai sound)
22 nd September	gym, mystery, physical, myth, system, pyramid, Egypt, hymn, symbol, gymnastics (y for short i sound)
29 th September	school, Christmas, chemist, scheme, chorus, echo, stomach, character, ache, anchor (/k/ sound spelt 'ch')
6 th October	tongue, league, fatigue, plague, vague, mosque, unique, antique, cheque, technique (gue and que word endings)
13 th October	chalet, chef, machine, brochure, parachute, chute, crochet, quiche, brioche, chiffon (/sh/ as 'ch')
20 th October	double, trouble, young, touch, country, cousin, enough, rough, tough (short 'u' sound spelt 'ou')
