

Maple Class Autumn Term Home Learning Challenges

In addition to your weekly spellings and reading homework, I would like you to choose **AT LEAST TWO BUT NO MORE THAN FOUR ACTIVITIES** from the eight suggestions below. For each activity you will score a certain amount of merits depending on its quality, length, presentation and the effort you have made. Please return your Home Learning Challenges book to school by **Monday 28th November** so your learning can be shared with the whole class. **HAVE FUN!!!**

Research then either draw and colour or make some Egyptian amulets. Explain what they were used for and why you've chosen your design. (3 merits)

Research the colour and relative sizes of the planets then use your creativity to make a model of The Solar System. (3 merits)

Make either a marshmallow model or snack. Write out your instructions or recipe and include photographs of yourself creating it. (3 merits)

Research hieroglyphs then use them to write a coded message. Make sure you provide the solution/de-coded message! (3 merits)

Either re-tell an Egyptian myth or write your own Egyptian themed story. Present it in words or as a comic strip. (3 merits)

How were mummies made? Research the process then write detailed - and illustrated- instructions. (3 merits)

Make a poster with pictures of and interesting facts about pyramids. Research, effort and excellent presentation will earn most merits! (3 merits)

Research the International Space Station then write a diary entry of an astronaut living and working there. (3 merits)
