Dear Parents and Carers,

We have organised a visit to Quarry Bank Mill on Friday 13th November to support and enrich our next Topic, which is 'What was the Impact of the Industrial Revolution on children's lives?' The children will learn about the lives of the children who worked in the mill and lived in the Apprentice House during the Industrial Revolution.
