Dear Parents and Carers,

Maple Class. Quarry Bank Mill

We have organised a visit to Quarry Bank Mill on Thursday 14th December 2023 to support and enrich our next Topic, which is 'What was the Impact of the Industrial Revolution on children's lives?' The children will learn about the lives of the children who worked in the mill and lived in the Apprentice House during the Industrial Revolution. The subsidised cost of the visit is £21.00. Please note that although this is a voluntary contribution, the visit will not go ahead if we do not receive sufficient funds. The cost includes coach fare, the admission charge and the service of guides.

We will leave school at 9:00 am and return by 3:30 pm, subject to traffic. The children will require a packed lunch in a disposable carrier bag labelled with their name. If your child has school dinners and you would like to order a packed lunch for the visit, please contact the school office (the choice of sandwich filling will be ham, cheese, tuna mayonnaise or egg mayonnaise). Because of the Mill's required adult to children ratio, we are likely to need a couple of parent volunteers to accompany us so if you are available and willing to join us on this trip, please contact either Miss Smethurst or the school office.

The statement of consent box must be ticked on your School Money account to acknowledge receipt of this information and also to consent to your child participating in the visit. Please consent and make payment by Monday 3rd December 2023.
