Research then draw and label pictures of Victorian poor and rich children wearing typical clothing. How and why did their clothing differ? (3 merits)

Research and make a fact file of the jobs typically done by Victorian children. Which job do you think was the worst? Why? (3 merits)

Research Victorian schools then produce a poster or PowerPoint showing the similarities and differences between modern and Victorian schools. Which do you think is best? (3 merits)

Make a Victoria sponge cake. Provide the full recipe and pictures of you making it. Why was it named Victoria sponge? (3 merits)

Plan your dream trip to Florida in USA! Where would you go, what would you see and where would you stay? Include pictures! (3 merits)

Design a new chocolate Easter treat. Tell me what its ingredients would be and why you've chosen them. Include a picture of your treat's wrapper; make it colourful and eye-catching! (3 merits)

Where in North America would you most like to visit? Research your chosen destination then tell me about it through a poster, PowerPoint, Pic Collage or fact file - you choose! (3 merits)
