## Answers and Explanations

### Spelling Reasoning: Yr 5/6 words: 6

#### 1. lightning

- Root word is *light*
- *light* not *lite* – same as the root word
- *ning* not *ening* – say the word clearly with two syllables, not three

#### 2. desperate

- Linked to *despair*
- *des* not *dis* (say the word clearly)
- *per* not *perr* (vowel does not need protecting as the stress is on the first syllable: desperate)
- *ate* not *at* – use a spelling voice to help with this

#### 3. explanation

- Root word is *explain*
- *ex* not *ecs* (same as in the root word)
- *plan* not *plain* – this word has an ‘a’ sound not a ‘ay’ sound or you could use a clue to help remember this: *plan the explanation*
- ‘ay’ sound before a ‘shn’ ending is often spelt ‘a’
- ‘shn’ sound is usually spelt *tion* (Tip: shoot the ti – on)

#### 4. development

- Linked to *develop*
- *dev* not *div* (say the word clearly)
- *el* not *ell* (vowel does not need protecting as the stress is on the first syllable: development)
- *op* not *up* (say the word clearly)
- *ment* not *meant* – the ‘ment’ suffix is spelt *ment*

#### 5. systematic

- Root word is *system*
- *sys* not *sis* – same as in the root word *system*
- *tem* not *tam* (say the word clearly)
- *a* not *e* (say the word clearly)
- *tic* not *tick* – the ‘ik’ sound at the end of a long word is usually spelt *ic*

#### 6. thorough

- *thor* not *thur* – contains the word ‘or’ (use a spelling voice or a clue to learn this)
- *ough* not *uh* – words rarely end in *uh*. Similar spelling to words like *borough* and *rough* (although this has a different sound).

#### 7. restaurants

- *res* not *ris* – same as in the word *rest*
- *taur* not *tor* – contains ‘au’ (use a spelling voice or a clue to learn this)
- *ants* not *ents* (say the word clearly)

#### 8. accordingly

- Root word is *accord*
- *acc* not *ac* – the ‘k’ sound at the beginning of a word between two vowels is often spelt ‘cc’
- *ord* not *oard* – same as in the root word *accord*
- *ing* not *ding* – vowel does not need protecting
- *ly* not *lee* – *ly* suffix added to the root word
