# **Spelling Reasoning: Rule 17: sion / tion**

#### 1. selection

- Root word is select
- sel not sell
- ec not eck ('k' sound in the middle of a long word is usually spelt 'c')
- 'shn' sound is usually spelt tion (Tip: <u>sh</u>oot the ti – on)

#### 2. division

- Linked to the word divide
- Contains the word vision
- *di* not *de* (say the word clearly)
- 'zhun' sound is usually spelt sion (as in vision)

#### 3. education

- Root word is educate
- ed not ej (say the word clearly)
- 'you' sound in a word is often spelt 'u'
- 'shn' sound is usually spelt tion (Tip: shoot the ti – on)

#### 4. conversation

- Linked to the word converse
- con not conn (vowel does not need protecting)
- *ver* not *var* (say the word clearly)
- 'ay' sound before a 'shn' ending is often spelt 'a'
- 'shn' sound is usually spelt tion (Tip: <u>sh</u>oot the ti – on)

#### 5. confusion

- Root word is confuse
- con not cun (say the word clearly)
- 'you' sound in a word is often spelt 'u'
- 'zhun' sound is usually spelt sion (as in vision)

## 6. application

- Root word is apply
- app not ap (same as in the root word)
- li not ly (change 'y' to 'i' because there is not a vowel before the 'y' in the root word apply)
- 'ay' sound before a 'shn' ending is often spelt 'a'
- 'shn' sound is usually spelt tion (Tip: shoot the ti – on)

### 7. explosion

- Root word is explode
- ex not ecs (ex means out)
- 'oh' sound before a 'zhun' ending is often spelt 'o'
- 'zhun' sound is usually spelt *sion* (as in *vision*)

### 8. organisation

- Root word is organise
- or not oar usually at the beginning of a word
- gan not gen (say the word clearly)
- 'igh' sound is spelt 'i' (same as in the root word organise)
- 'ay' sound before a 'shn' ending is often spelt 'a'
- 'shn' sound is usually spelt tion (Tip: <u>sh</u>oot the ti – on)
