# Activities

## **What if a child doesn't want to take part in an activity?**

At Robinwood, we take a child-centred approach to all activities. While children are encouraged to try new experiences, no one is ever forced to take part. Each activity is designed to involve every child at a level they feel comfortable with—for example, using belaying safety ropes. Children are supported by the same Group Leader throughout all activities, helping to build trust and consistent support, which encourages them to try new things and grow in confidence.

# Organisation and Reminders

- We need to set off at 9:15am and will leave the site at 2pm. A text will be sent when close to school. (Approximately 3:30pm/4pm)
- Please ensure your child has all the clothing recommended, which is labelled! Clothing may need to be washed and dried on site and easily returned to children!
- Medicines- with details of how/when to administer- will be collected on the morning before departure. (Take travel sickness tablet before leaving for school and we will administer on return home – if needed)
- Bags must be carried to dormitories by the children- don't make them too big/heavy
- No phones, electronic devices, cameras, additional food or sweets are allowed- they will be confiscated by staff
- Lots of photos will be taken by our staff and shared

# Organisation and Reminders

## **Do you cater for fussy eaters?**

Our menu is balanced and filling, ensuring all children are fuelled for the day's activities. If a child does not like an item on the menu, there are always alternatives available. The catering team works directly with the child and a teacher to ensure they select meals they will enjoy. Children choose all their meals for the entire trip on the first day, giving them peace of mind so they can focus on having fun. Schools can speak to their School Liaison ahead of the trip if a child may need extra support or preparation with their meal choices.

# Suggested Clothing List

There is no need to go out and buy anything special for a trip to Robinwood, all specialist equipment is provided. The clothing list given includes clothing being worn on the journey (so if you are wearing a pair of trousers for the journey, you only need to pack 2 more pairs).

- 3 Comfortable long-sleeved tops (sweatshirts/jumpers/hoodies/fleeces)
- • 3 T-shirts (not vest type)
- • 3 Pairs of trousers (not restrictive; sportswear is good/ideally not jeans)
- • 2 Pairs of shorts (knee length)
- • 5 Sets of underwear
- • 6 Pairs of socks
- • 2 Pairs of trainers
- • 2 Towels
- • 1 Waterproof coat
- • 1 Sun hat (in warm weather)
- • 1 Set of nightwear
- • 1 Bag of toiletries (including suntan lotion and insect repellent in warm weather)
- • 1 Black bin liner

## **What if the weather is bad?**

Each Robinwood centre has excellent indoor facilities to minimise the impact of extreme weather. Over 50% of our activities already take place indoors. If an activity becomes unsafe due to weather, a suitable alternative activity will be provided to ensure the children continue to have a full and enjoyable experience.
