This Accessibility Plan outlines how Christ Church CE Primary School intends to improve access to education for pupils with disabilities, in accordance with the Equality Act 2010.

1. Purpose of the Plan

The purpose of this plan is to set out the commitment of Christ Church CE Primary School to provide an inclusive environment that enables all pupils, including those with disabilities, to access the curriculum, the physical environment, and information.

2. Objectives

Our objectives are to:

- Increase access to the curriculum for pupils with disabilities.
- Improve the physical environment to enable disabled pupils to take better advantage of education and services.
- Improve the availability of accessible information to disabled pupils and parents.

3. Current Position

Christ Church CE Primary School has made progress in improving accessibility and continues to review and enhance provisions. The school works closely with The Sycamore Church of England Trust to ensure compliance and best practice.

4. Action Plan

The following actions will be taken over the next three years to improve accessibility:

a) Curriculum Access

- Staff training on inclusive teaching strategies.
- Use of assistive technologies and differentiated resources.

b) Physical Environment

- Regular audits of school premises to identify barriers.
- Improvements to signage, lighting, and access routes.

c) Information Access

- Provide key documents in accessible formats upon request.
- Maintain clear and readable website content.

5. Monitoring and Review

This plan will be reviewed annually by the school leadership team and updated as necessary. Progress will be reported to the Local Governing Board and The Sycamore Church of England Trust.
