

Operation Encompass

Our school is involved in a project that is a Police Initiative working with Bury Safeguarding Board.

The project, Operation Encompass, has been designed to provide early reporting to schools of any domestic abuse incidents that occur outside of school but which might have an impact on a child attending school the following day. This information is shared on school days during the school term. When incidents occur on a Friday, Saturday or a Sunday, the police contact the relevant school the following Monday.

A nominated member of school staff, known as a Key Adult, are trained to liaise with the police. At Christ Church School our Key Adult is Mrs Howard. They are able to use information that has been shared with them, in confidence, to ensure that the school is able to support children and their families. Information is shared where it is identified that a child or young person was present, witnessed or was involved in a domestic abuse incident.

We always endeavour to offer the best support possible to our pupils and believe that Operation Encompass is a very beneficial and supportive process for all concerned children and families.
