- The draw will take place in the last assembly each month

100 Club Rules

Purpose

The purpose of the 100 is to raise funds for the school (Christ Church Walshaw). The money will be paid into the Friends of Christ Church bank account and used to meet funding requests from the school, provide equipment, resources and opportunities for every pupil.

Rules

1. For a cost of £1 per month (i.e. per draw) you will be allocated a number between one and 100
2. A draw will be made every month with a 1st prize
3. The prize will total £25 each month with the exception of December which will be two draws of £50
4. The 100 club is a private lottery and is open to anyone aged 16 or over
5. Payments must be made by standing order (**preferably annually**). One month's notice is required for cancellation
6. Member's numbers will only be entered if their subscription is up to date
7. If a member has no valid reason for missing a payment, their number may be sold to someone on the reserve list
8. The draw shall be made by the headteacher in the last assembly of each month
9. No draws will be completed in July and August
10. Contact will be made with the winner and the winnings will be transferred to the winner's bank account within one week of the draw
11. The name and numbers for each month's winners will be posted in the school newsletter and on the Friends Facebook Page
12. The 100 club will be run by Friends of Christ Church Walshaw. In case of any dispute the decision of the committee is final
13. Unless otherwise advised, a member will be deemed to have left 100 club if his/her subscription renewal remains unpaid for a period of one month
14. If a winner cannot be contacted, the winnings will be placed into the Friends of Christ Church funds after six months
15. If a number is drawn which is unallocated, 50% of this prize draw will roll over and 50% will be placed into the Friends of Christ Church funds
