We know that every family faces challenges and difficulties at different points in their lives - and in their children's lives - and that this is completely normal!



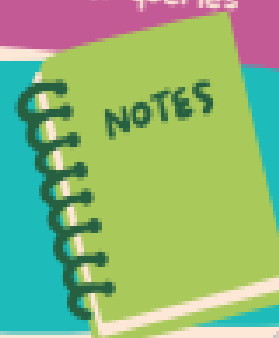
