- Spelling test on Friday.

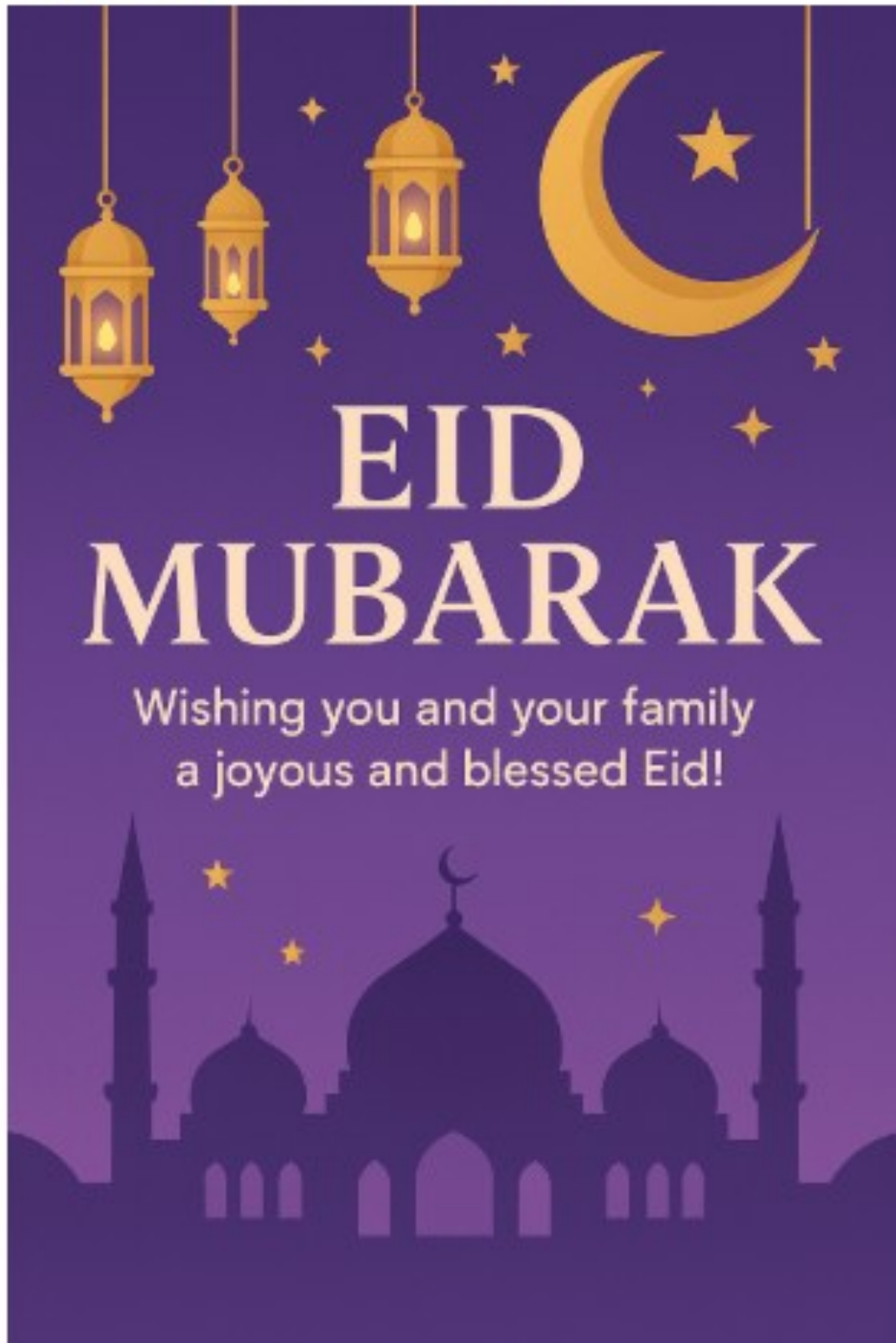
Maple Class:
