There is an opportunity for a group of children from Year 5 to attend Robinwood with the current Year 6 class. If your child is interested, please let us know at the office. If more than 6 children are interested, names will be selected out of a hat. It would be great for a group of friends to attend together. The children in Year 5 will be going as a cohort, to the Wrexham Centre (a different venue), next year when they are in Year 6 (more information to follow in the summer term). For the past few years, it has only been Year 6's who have attended as all the spaces were taken but this year up to 6 spaces have become available. Dear Parents and Carers,

I am delighted to let you know that we have booked our residential visit for Year 6 children to Robinwood. We are going to Dobroyd Castle, in Todmorden, which is a super centre, we've visited a number of times before and always had great fun with excellent activity leaders. The visit will be a marvellous experience for the children and staff. The residential element is very important, giving children the chance to be independent and stay away from home, whilst the activities the children engage with provide opportunities for pupils to work as a team, problem solve and experience thrills and challenges; examples of the activities are the giant swing, zipwire, caving, archery and the dreaded piranha pool!!

Due to rising operational costs at the centre, the cost of visiting Robinwood has seen a big increase. School will be subsidising the total cost of this visit by £60 per child plus covering the travel costs. Therefore, the subsidised cost of the trip, including all meals, activities, transport and fully comprehensive insurance is £340.

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The full amount must be paid by 16th May 2025. You can pay the rest in amounts as you wish, over the next few months, using School Money.

If you wish to discuss any aspect of this visit, including the cost, before making a commitment for your child, then please do not hesitate to contact school. There will be a meeting for parents before the visit takes place with detailed information about activities, accommodation and itinerary.
