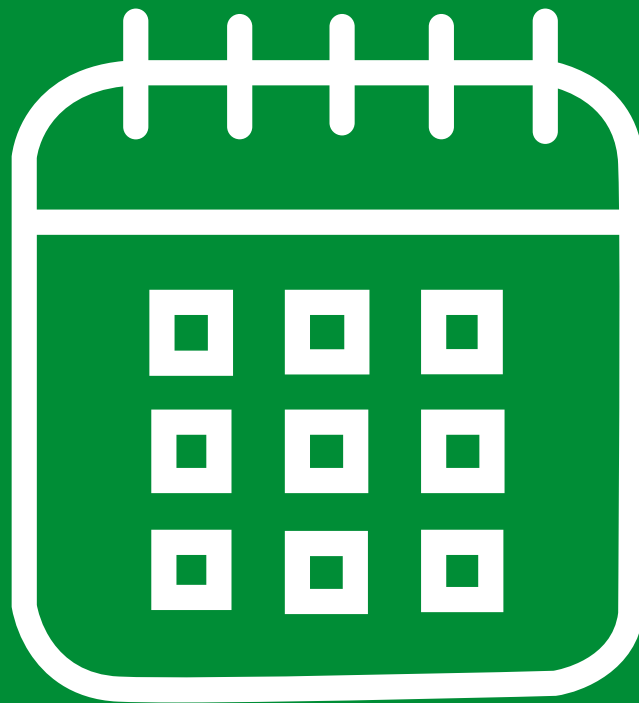


Welcome to our weekly update letter circulated to local partners, organisations, and groups across Bury North.

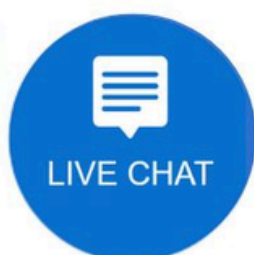
